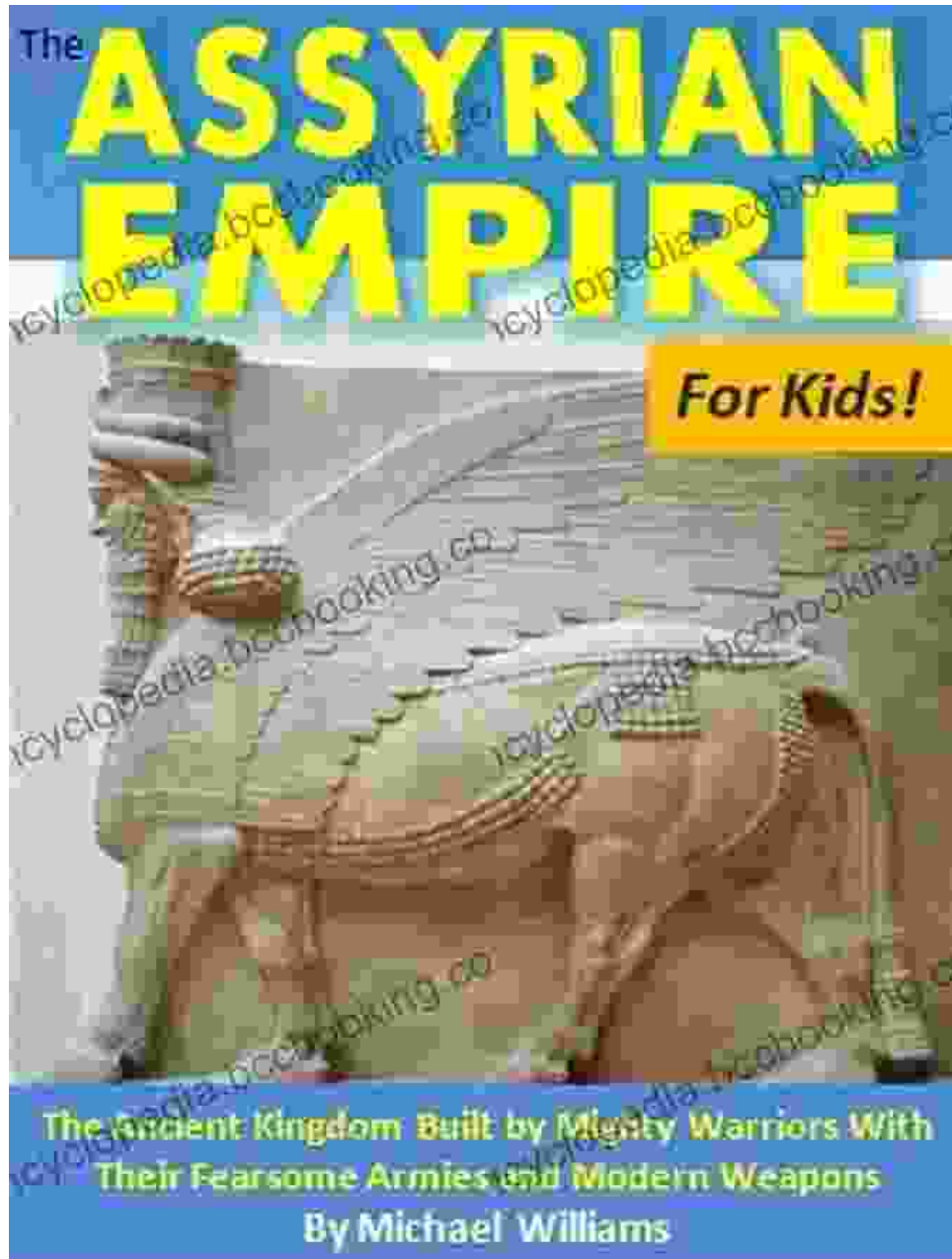

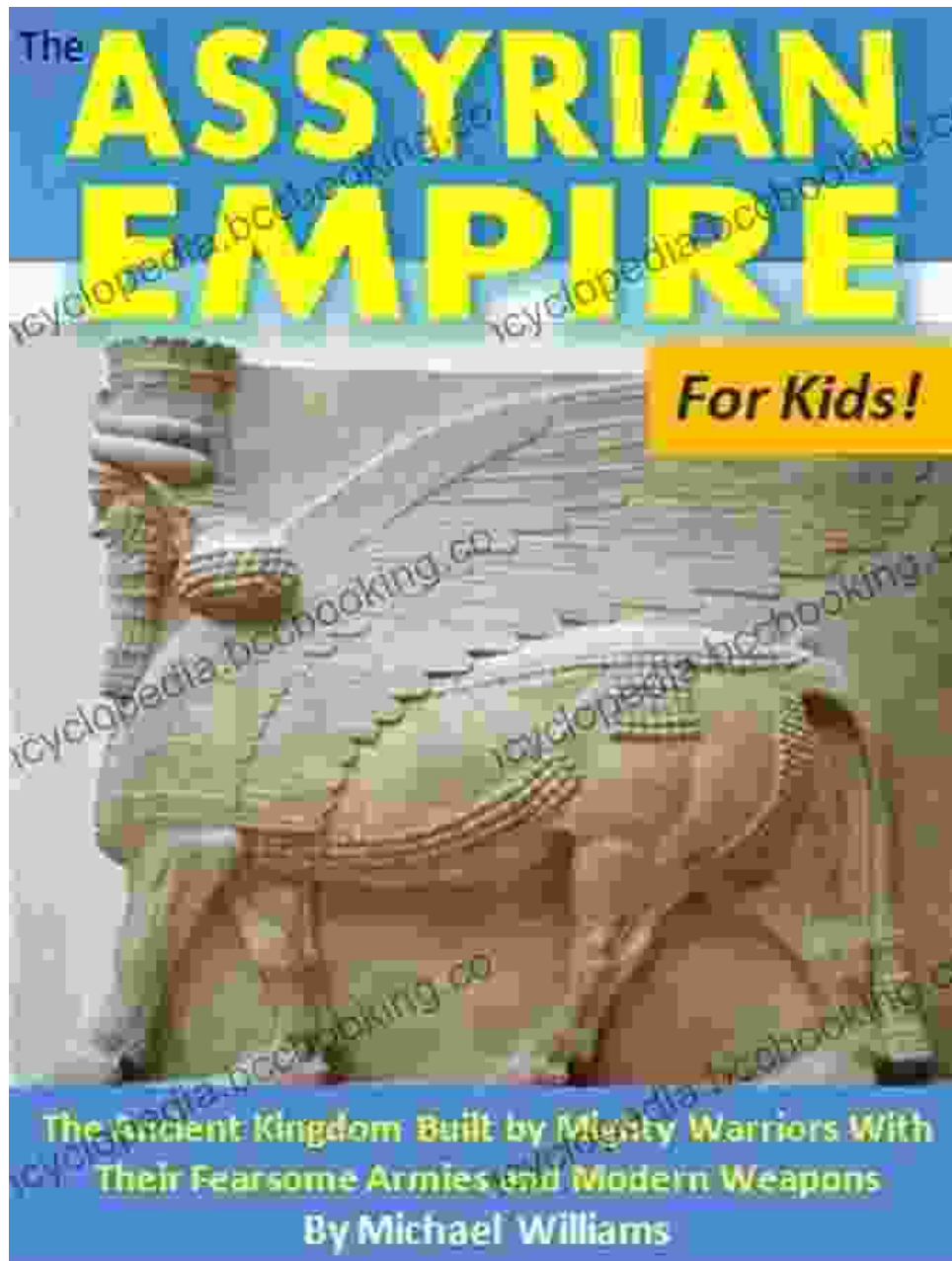

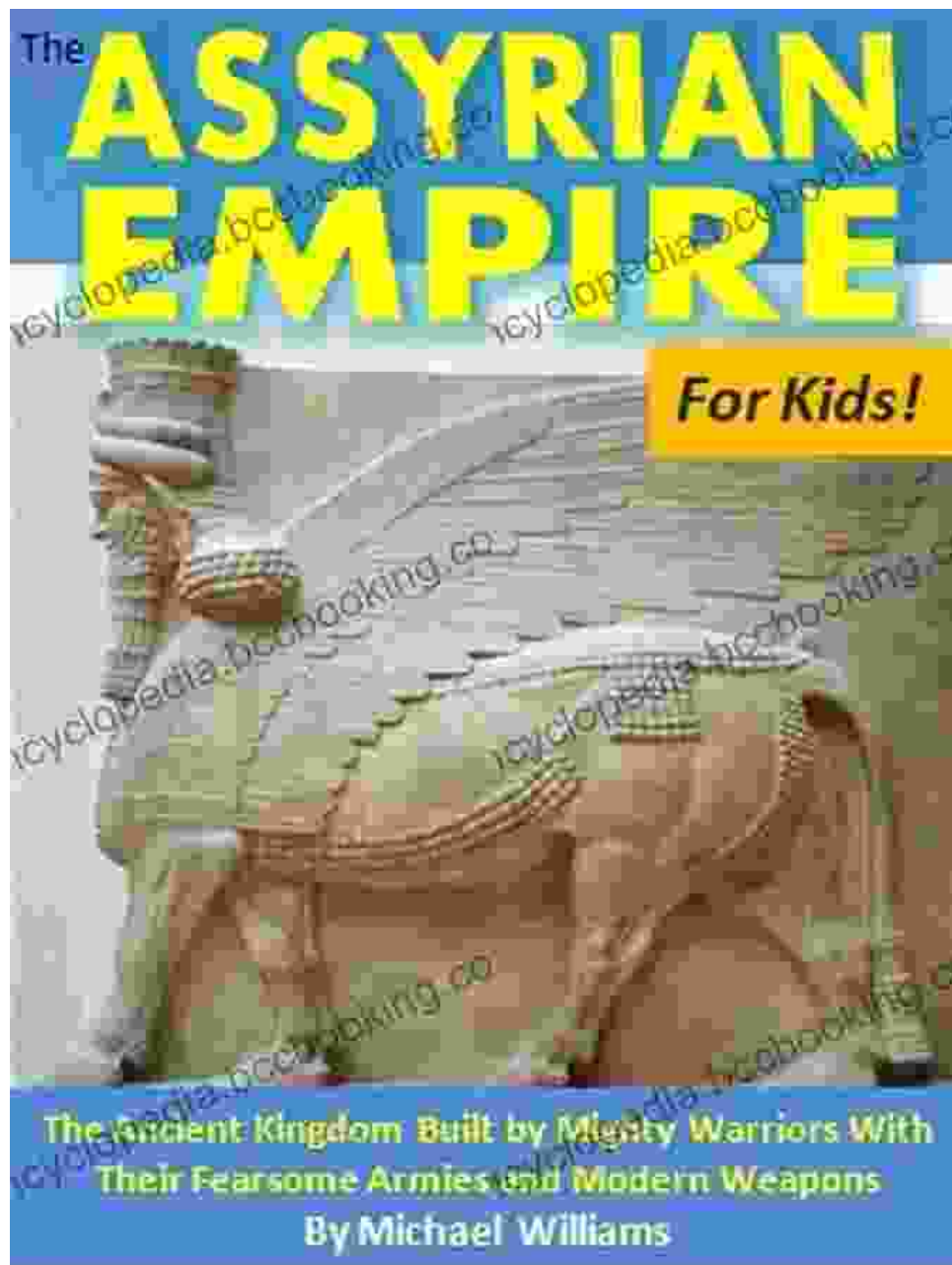


A majestic winged bull from the palace of Sargon II

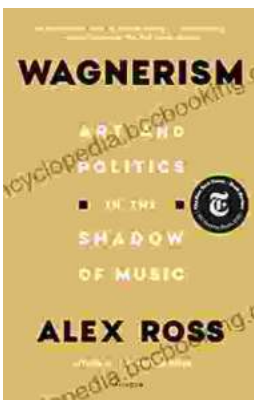
